Such a transition not only brings a sense of immediacy toward contemporary discourse, but also widens the conversation across a multitude of different cultural audiences, much like how contemporary artists such as Die Antwoord have negotiated the complicated realities of their personal and professional identities within contemporary sociopolitical context (Ward, 2022). Thus, the emergence and evolution of commentary tools bottomless impact on how football commentary is produced and consumed increases it even more for all stakeholders.

B- Effects of social media on styles of commentary

There has been a huge change in how we enjoy commentaries, be it in football, cricket or any other sport, and one of the biggest factors in this shift is the rise of social media. Social media platforms such as Twitter, Instagram, and more recently TikTok have democratized sports commentary, creating space for fans and amateur analysts to share their thoughts in real time. The immediacy of online language has resulted in a much more casual, conversational tone in professional commentary — one that, perhaps more than ever before, allows humor and personality to come heavily into play. However, memes and humorous references, similar to the viral

media that erupts out of instances like the COVID-19 pandemic, have allowed commentary to become not only informative but entertaining (Nicholls, 2020). Moreover, parallels made in other fields, such as through the depiction of athletes during College Game Day broadcasts, demonstrate how social medias power can reinforce stereotypes in the real world (Haslerig, 2018). As such, the combination of traditional commentary and social media dynamics makes for a multi-faceted landscape that caters to a wider audience, heralding how commentary in the future will take place for sporting events.

C-Changes in audience expectations of Intonation via technology

With technological advances the expectations of football audiences have undergone dramatic shifts in how games are commented on on screen, Twenty-first-century viewers now expect a seamless mix of on-demand information and participatory storytelling that helps them understand the dynamics of the game. Where a radio voice alone could once carry a broadcast, now an audience expects multi-platform experiences that include live statistics, advanced analytics, and interactive elements. As aptly observed amidst the juxtaposition of the booming humor of the pandemic, a manifestation of society's resilience to and a reflection of the adversities that it encounters as a community (Nicholls, 2020), so has the engagement of an audience with content: adapted by including humour and wit in commentary, through cultural intertextual references and touchstones. On another hand. the transdisciplinary approach found in previous research highlights the importance of innovation and creativity in broadcasting methods (Anca, 2020), prompting commentators to deviate from traditional methods of storytelling in response to risen stakes. Thus, football commentary has become a dialogic interaction that combines technology, and narrative in a way that can engage the viewer better.

V – Conclusion

To sum up, the unique features of football commentary show that intonation is crucial for rendering the viewers' interpretation and involvement to a considerable extent. By looking closely at language practices, it's possible to see how commentators create excitement and otherwise convey critical information. Just as cricket commentary creates a particular ambience through the use special syntactic constructions and the ubiquitous presence of jargon (Naveed, 2021), football commentary uses these dynamic intonation patterns to convey the excitement of the game. Moreover, according to the findings from a recent study, the common forms of online communication strategies in distance learning modalities indicate the transformation of engagement strategies and highlight the importance of interactive and direct replies (Farneste, 2021). As a result, this application of intonation not only makes for a more gripping experience for the audiences watching at home, but also helps in forming a stronger bond between a viewer and the sport itself, further solidifying sports place in transcending entertainment.

Synopsis of what was covered

A few important notes can be drawn from the study of intonation in the commentary language of football which sharpen the role of study in upgrading the listeners or audience engagement and understanding. The pitch, tone, and rhythm combine to create the thrill or passion of the game as commentators deliver the big news about goals or other significant events. Additionally, in a study on students' perceptions of English grammar instruction, the instructor's move toward pedagogical environments characterized by social distance illustrates the need for strategies of dynamic communication, which can easily translate into sport commentary in real time (Balteiro, 2018).

While our discussion focused on feedback systems and the importance of being able to ask immediate questions, Nicholls suggest that this same communication is needed for both educational settings and sport commentary because how information is presented will keep the attention of the audience and importantly, instil understanding.

And so, analysis of intonation illustrates not only the art of commentary but also that engagement is a pathway into memorable sports storytelling.

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
